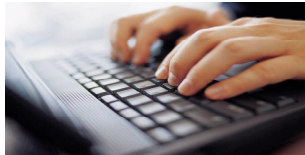


Introducing the Collaboratory for Adolescent Literacy Leaders (CALL)

A multi-year professional development program that builds literacy leadership among content-area teachers and high school teams



The CALL prepares content teachers to:

- integrate literacy instruction into the subjects they teach (math, science, social studies, ELA)
- improve the academic achievement of their students
- develop as instructional leaders.

The CALL introduces content teachers to the Adolescent Literacy Support Framework, a resource developed by The Education Alliance that draws from research in cognitive psychology, linguistics, education, English language arts, second language acquisition, and reading. The Framework identifies proven practices for improving adolescent literacy (a key to academic success in core subjects), and the CALL provides teachers with expert face-to-face and online assistance as they learn about and implement these practices in alignment with content lessons and Common Core Standards.

Supporting one or more CALL teams is an investment in school-wide literacy reform. The resources Brown provides, and the expertise developed within participating team members, are systematically shared throughout the school during and after the initial year.

The technologies and face-to-face meetings employed during the CALL provide participants an opportunity for ongoing discussions with literacy experts, and with same-subject teachers at other sites. During the school year, these literacy proficient teacher practitioners serve remotely as content-specific coaches, sharing insights about how they regularly integrate literacy strategies into their own lessons.
